# AC Milan Football Summer Camps: AC Milan Academy Camp

## Introduction

The AC Milan Academy Camps are the **official weekly summer football camps** organized by AC Milan for **boys and girls aged 6 to 16 years** during summer (mainly in June, July and August) at prestigious seaside, mountain, or city locations.

Sporteventi Sports Association has been AC Milan's partner since **2000**, and is today one of the longest-standing and **most successful organizers** of AC Milan Academy Camps for the Rossoneri.

In 2016, Sporeventi was also featured by the prestigious American newspaper The New York Times.

In particular, Sporeventi manages prestigious **mountain locations** for AC Milan, such as **Cortina d’Ampezzo** (Dolomites – Alps) and **Asiago Plateau – Gallio** (Alps), as well as renowned **seaside locations** such as **Jesolo Lido** (Venice) and **Lignano Sabbiadoro** (Venice area).

### Training Methodology

**Technical training** is organized following **AC Milan’s official methodologies**, guaranteeing a structured and high-quality learning path. Participants are **divided by age groups**, and through targeted exercises, technical games and team tournaments, they have the opportunity to develop and enhance both football skills and athletic abilities.

The camp, however, **is not just football**: numerous recreational activities complete the experience, offering moments of **fun, socialization and shared growth** with all other participants.

Our focus is to make the AC Milan Academy Camp experience an important opportunity to stimulate **responsibility** in participants, to consolidate the **value of rules and education**, and to experience a moment of **unforgettable passion**.

## Staff Excellence

The staff that will follow you on and off the field is composed of figures of excellence:

**Technical Supervisor – Football Legend:** an authentic Legend, that is, a former footballer or internationally renowned coach, who supports the staff by transmitting their experience, values and passion for sport to the boys

**AC Milan Technical Director:** a coach from the **AC Milan Youth Sector** or **Milan Academy**

**Sporteventi's Coaching Manager and Coaching Staff:** a team of qualified coaches who follow the boys, on and off the field, for the entire day

**Assistants:** support staff constantly assisting the boys, both on the field and in daily activities

The Technical Supervisor is a unique asset for us in Italy and Europe, thanks to constant collaboration since Sporteventi's founding with authentic football legends (**Pierino Prati, Gino Maldera, Maurizio Ganz, Filippo Galli, Stefano Eranio, Diego Bortoluzzi, Pietro Vierchowod, Cristian Lantignotti** and **Walter De Vecchi**) who have alternated as Supervisors at Sporteventi-organized AC Milan Academy Camps over the years.

We ensure **attentive assistance** and continuous supervision, 24 hours a day.

Our goal is to give the boys an unforgettable, safe and emotionally rich experience, **ensuring parents that the safety of their children is always our priority**. AC Milan Academy Camps are therefore the best way to experience an unforgettable summer in the spirit of football and Rossoneri colors.

## Participants and Internationality

AC Milan Academy Camps are open to **boys and girls aged 6 to 16 years from all nationalities, both in groups or individually**.

They are a unique life experience also thanks to their **international character**, with the presence of participants from **over 60 different nations** (USA, United Kingdom, France, Germany, Switzerland, United Arab Emirates, China, Japan, etc.).

**All our staff speaks Italian and English** and the AC Milan Academy Camp is primarily managed in English.

## Costs and Services

### AC MILAN ACADEMY CAMP: “JUNIOR” FORMULA and “DAY” FORMULA

#### AC Milan Academy Camp - “Junior” Formula

AC Milan Academy Camp - Junior Formula is the **residential camp** with **hotel accommodation** with other participants. The weekly fees for Jesolo Lido, Lignano Sabbiadoro, Cortina d’Ampezzo and Asiago Plateau - Gallio include:

- Board and lodging from Sunday afternoon (2:00 PM, lunch excluded) to Saturday afternoon (1:00 PM, lunch included)
- Sports activities
- AC Milan Academy - Puma - Fly Better sports kit
- Daily kit washing (technical material used during training only - NO underwear)
- Weekly insurance against accidents and liability
- Transport to and from the football field(s)
- Tourist tax

The quoted fees are all-inclusive, except for phone expenses and beverage consumption (except water). **In case of multiple weeks, a single sports kit will still be delivered on the Sunday camp begins.**

(\*) For participants wishing to attend **two consecutive weeks**, remaining at camp under Sporteventi staff supervision, an additional fee of **€130.00** (Cortina d'Ampezzo), **€130.00** (Gallio - Asiago Plateau), **€115.00** (Jesolo Lido) and **€110.00** (Lignano Sabbiadoro) is required for Saturday dinner and lodging, Sunday breakfast and lunch, and full supervision during this period.





### **AC Milan Academy Camp - “Day” Formula**

AC Milan Junior Camp — Day Formula is a **day camp without hotel accommodation**, available for participants who can reach daily the camp locations of Cortina d’Ampezzo, Jesolo Lido, Asiago Plateau - Gallio and Lignano Sabbiadoro.

The camp runs from 8:45 AM (breakfast not included) to 6:45 PM (dinner not included). Weekly fees for the Milan Junior Day Camp at Jesolo Lido, Lignano Sabbiadoro, Cortina d’Ampezzo and Asiago Plateau - Gallio include:

- Lunch from Monday to Saturday
- Sports activities
- AC Milan Academy - Puma - Fly Emirates sports kit
- Daily kit washing (technical material used during training only - NO underwear)
- Weekly insurance against accidents and liability
- Transport to and from the sports field

The Day Formula program is identical to the Junior Formula, with the exception that the “Day” formula **DOES NOT INCLUDE** the following services:

- Accommodation (hotel/village)
- Breakfast
- Dinner

The quoted fees are all-inclusive, except for phone expenses and beverage consumption (except water). **In case of multiple weeks, a single sports kit will still be delivered on the Sunday camp begins.**

### **ACCOMMODATION (AC Milan Academy Camp - Junior Formula only)**

The registration fee for AC Milan Academy summer camp participants with the “JUNIOR” formula includes accommodation in a 3-star or superior hotel with full board, from Sunday afternoon (lunch excluded) to Saturday morning (lunch included). The registration fee for “DAY” formula participants includes all lunches from Monday to Saturday.

## **INSURANCE**

Sporteventi, to protect AC Milan Academy Camp participants, provides civil liability insurance toward third parties with a maximum coverage of €5,000,000.

Individual accident and injury insurance is not valid for non-Italian participants. Therefore, **NON-ITALIAN** participants must arrange their own insurance covering accident, illness and hospitalization risks during their stay in Italy, for a minimum amount of € 200,000.

The **AC Milan Academy Camp** will take place in the splendid setting of the sports-tourism village “**Bella Italia EFA Village**”.

A unique location spanning **60 hectares of pine forest** with **1200 m of private beach**. The facility features 13 accommodation units with total capacity of 2800 people, offering exceptional spaces and services.



The Village allows boys to experience a **360-degree experience**: from training on **regulation football fields** (including latest-generation synthetic grass) to recreational activities, including the **sports complex, pools** and the **sea**. Everything is designed to make the Camp complete and unforgettable.

**Safety** and **peace of mind** are our priority: surveillance is guaranteed **24 hours a day**, also within accommodations and apartments. Furthermore, a **medical clinic** is always present.

## TYPICAL DAY SCHEDULE

Campers arrive at their chosen location on **Sunday**, where, from **2:00 PM** onwards, immediate check-in occurs with assignment of the **AC Milan Academy kit**; by 4:00 PM the boys are already on the field for the first training session, which mainly serves the coaches to give initial directives about the camp's continuation and required conduct.

**Friday evening** features the **awards ceremony**, with parent presence, to award **trophies** and **medals** to players and teams who won the individual and group challenges held on weekday afternoons from Monday to Friday; all participants receive the **AC Milan Academy Camp participation certificate** and a **video** filmed by staff during the week is screened. Finally, the special "**Pierino Prati**" award is given to the most orderly and respectful participants in the hotel: the prize consists of a ball for each member of the winning room.

**Saturday morning** features **friendly/demonstration 11v11 matches** and camp ends with lunch.

The typical AC Milan Academy Camp program includes **two training**



**sessions** daily, one in the morning and one in the afternoon, two hours each. The rest of the day is spent in **recreational and leisure activities** (TV room, group games, karaoke, Junior Park, water park, etc.).

A recovery afternoon is also scheduled (usually Wednesday) to allow campers’ physical and mental recovery.

### Typical Daily Schedule Time

In case of AC Milan Academy Camp – Day formula, the participant does not stay at hotel, being probably resident in the camp location, and arrives at hotel/Village each morning (around 8:20/8:40 AM) to head to the football field with the whole group, then returns to family after afternoon training (around 6:30 PM) or evening training (around 9:30 PM) if applicable.

## TRAINING - TECHNICAL PROGRAM

Each location is managed and coordinated by a **Sporteventi’s Coaching Manager**, also **AC Milan Academy Camp Technical Director**.

The **Sporteventi’s Coaching Manager (Technical Director)** has technical direction of the camp, planning the technical-football aspects in accordance with guidelines established by the AC Milan Youth Sector and AC Milan Academy.

The Sporteventi’s Coaching Manager collaborates with the AC Milan

Technical Director and the Technical Supervisor present.

The Sporteventi's Coaching Manager coordinates the **coaches present at camp (approximately one per 10/12 boys)** and is also responsible for camp site logistics and generally for the entire local organization of the football camp.

Campers are primarily divided by **age group, physical build** and possibly **technical ability**, which is tested initially upon arrival at camp (Sunday afternoon).

**Main age groups** are:

- 7-8 years old
- 9-11 years old
- 12-16 years old

**The work done in different groups** corresponds roughly to the following:

- **7-8 years old:** primarily **ball work** (ball control, dribbling, shooting)
- **9-11 years old:** **ball work** and **tactical-technical** (games 3 vs 2 or 2 vs 1, zone or man marking, movement without the ball)
- **12-16 years old:** primarily **tactical-technical** work

Mornings are typically dedicated to **technical stations**; afternoons are used for **team or individual tournaments** (accuracy shots, shot out, American-style penalties, Italian-style penalties, free kick shots).

Generally — in mountain locations only — Wednesday or Thursday afternoon physical field work is suspended to allow campers to recover from accumulated training. **Recovery** is done in the pool, where the location or hotel has adequate facilities, or an excursion is organized in the area surrounding the host location.

**Training** is structured based on the **AC Milan Integrated Method**, an ensemble of **training methodologies and programs** developed by



the AC Milan Youth Sector to simultaneously pursue a **variety of complementary objectives** belonging to different areas:

- **Technical-tactical area**
- **Athletic area**
- **Psycho-relational area**
- **Educational area**

## **GOALKEEPERS**

During **AC Milan Academy Camps**, **goalkeepers** are provided with specific **AC Milan Academy kit** and follow a **specific training program** based on their field role's peculiarities.

During mornings they separate from the group and, with **dedicated coaches**, follow a tailored program. In afternoons, during team tournaments and individual challenges, they rejoin teammates to give their best between the “posts”.

## The AC Milan Integrated Method

During **AC Milan Academy Camps**, children and youth experience a **unique educational and relational experience**, in contact with peers and adults, both during free play and, naturally, on the field.

Each exercise is carefully designed and above all proposed with the **objective to have fun**, helping participants overcome fear of mistakes and develop collaborative spirit with teammates.

AC Milan Academy Camps do not aim to develop champions, but to **put each participant** in conditions to **best express their own talent which, small or great, represents for us and for them something truly precious**.

The **AC Milan methodology** is distinguished by its **multidisciplinary approach** toward the athlete; each training session is designed and structured to pursue simultaneously a **plurality of complementary goals** connected to the following **macro-areas**:

- Technical-tactical area
- Athletic area
- Psycho-relational area
- Educational area

This tight interrelation of intents represents the **AC Milan Integrated Method**.

## FOOTBALL LEGENDS – TECHNICAL SUPERVISORS

**Technical Supervisors** are former **AC Milan players** of proven national and international prestige or technicians of highest technical and reputational profile. They are responsible for **supervising** the overall qualitative level of AC Milan Academy Camp and particularly **technical activity**, to ensure standards consistent with AC Milan's stature and aligned with Milan Academy (AC Milan) guidelines.

# SAFETY

## PARTICIPANT SAFETY COMES FIRST

Sporteventi provides the **perfect mix of coaches, educators and guardians** to all **AC Milan Academy Camp** participants; while we strive to ensure all boys are **happy and satisfied** with the camp program, parents can be assured that for us camper safety is the **most important priority**.

We at Sporteventi are fully aware of the **enormous responsibility** we have in caring for AC Milan Academy Camp participants and are completely focused on ensuring perfect success of this goal. Below we will detail the actions we take to ensure maximum safety before and during AC Milan Academy Camp activities.

## STAFF SELECTION

All **Sporteventi coaches** come from **AC Milan Football Schools** or very prestigious Italian football schools and are selected based on their **pedagogical and technical preparation**.

For us at Sporteventi, a coach is first and foremost an educator who must know how to dialogue with children of all ages and nationalities and must be able to empathize with them. We also pay particular attention to coach multilingualism.

## STAFF COMPOSITION AND NUMBERS

The complete staff (Technical Supervisor, AC Milan Technical Director, Sporteventi's Coaching Manager, Assistants, Goalkeeper Coaches, Coaches) allows for one staff member per 8 participants (**1:8 ratio**).

## STAFF AVAILABILITY

The Sporteventi Camp Head and assistants are reachable by parents day and night: their cell phone numbers are provided to parents in the camp program on the first day.

## ASSISTANT

The **assistant** supporting staff has **very complex duties**:

- manages **injuries** that might occur to boys both from field side, with medical kits and defibrillators, and at the hospital where she accompanies boys and assists during visits or therapies;
- manages **airport transfer** departures and arrivals in coordination with the office;
- assists staff in urgent needs;
- assists **younger boys** in case of homesickness;
- assists AC Milan Academy Camp participants during meals for specific **dietary needs** (celiac disease or allergies);
- assists participants for specific **pharmaceutical therapies** they were undergoing before camp or during camp;
- manages all laundry service.

## MULTILINGUALISM

The camp's official languages are **Italian** and **English**. Sporeventi's AC Milan Academy Camps host every year boys and girls from **65 different nations**, so much of the staff speaks English and English is the camp's primary language (alongside Italian).

## SUPERVISION AND TUTORING

### WAKE-UP (JUNIOR FORMULA)

Based on the location's daily program, wake-up is between 7:45 and 8:00 AM. Each AC Milan Academy Camp participant can independently set their own alarm, request hotel intercom alarm-setting, or as a last resort be woken by responsible coaches (2/4 per hotel floor). After wake-up, campers have 30 minutes to go to breakfast and eat.

### RECEPTION (DAY FORMULA)

Based on the daily program, AC Milan Academy Camp Day Formula participants report at the designated meeting point (hall, reception,

or directly to the football field); a specifically assigned staff member performs morning reception and takes charge of the participant.

## DAILY SCHEDULE

Staff always reminds AC Milan Academy Camp participants throughout the day of the **daily program**, so campers are always timely informed of activities that progressively occur from morning onwards.

## TRANSFER TO FOOTBALL FIELDS

At locations where transfer to fields is by bus, a division into training groups (small/medium/large) occurs and, once correct camper count is verified, boarding the private bus occurs exclusively for AC Milan Academy Camp participants. Participant monitoring continues constantly, whether going to the football field, on excursion, or simply taking a walk.

## CHANGING ROOMS

Responsible staff members for younger AC Milan Academy Camp participants always help and assist them; an assistant coach is present for them after training/matches to help collect technical/sports materials.

## HOTEL MONITORING

At each site, depending on hotel structure, when participants are in rooms or using hotel spaces, staff is organized to have at least one staff member in the hall, on floors and in the recreation/game room. Staff supervises boys' conduct to ensure it's appropriate respect toward a hotel facility, and prevents them from leaving independently.

## DAY AND NIGHT SURVEILLANCE

AC Milan Academy Camp participants are **always monitored, both night and day**.

During the day no participant is ever authorized to leave without a

Sporteventi staff member's presence, whether leaving the hotel for a few minutes or a sixteen-year-old boy (still a minor under Sporteventi custody).

At night surveillance occurs on every floor of used hotel facilities: staff members are distributed throughout participant floors also for their overnight stay. The hotel itself assists staff through 24-hour reception staff who alert staff if the participant acts improperly or independently.

## **STAFF BRIEFING**

The Sporteventi's Coaching Manager (Technical Director of the camp) always reminds all staff members of **checks** to perform and **timing** of daily activities. This happens at least **three times daily**: early morning before boys' breakfast; right after lunch; evening, after boys go to bed.

## **MEDICAL CARE AND HOSPITALS**

Each AC Milan Academy Camp location managed by Sporteventi is chosen also based on ability to **promptly receive medical care**.

So Cortina d'Ampezzo, Asiago Plateau and Jesolo Lido locations have public medical-hospital facilities able to promptly provide first aid if needed. The Bella Italia Sports Center, given its size (can accommodate up to 3,000 people), has an internal private medical clinic.

## **CELL PHONE, SMARTPHONE, HANDHELD USAGE INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS**

AC Milan Academy Camp participants can bring cell phones, smartphones and handheld devices exclusively to remain in contact with their families.

Phone calls to participants from parents are generally allowed (except real emergencies) from **1:15 PM to 2:00 PM** and from **8:15 PM to 8:45 PM**, that is after lunch and dinner.

To **moderate** and limit telephone and handheld use **during nighttime** (from 10:30 PM to 7:30 AM), at 10:00 PM — during the first room check — overnight participants (Junior formula) will be asked to deposit

their cell phones, smartphones and handheld devices in the room's **safe**. The **safe combination** will be set and known only to Sporteventi staff and hotel management. The safe will be reopened between 7:30 and 8:00 AM by staff. Devices (smartphones, cell phones and handhelds) can be charged by the participant during meals (use is not allowed in the dining room).

Sporteventi staff stays on the same participant floors. A second room check (verifying boys sleep and everything is peaceful) is done by staff at midnight.

Parents will have two phone numbers (Sporteventi's Coaching Manager and assistant) reachable anytime, day or night, in case of need. Staff is also reachable by campers even in the middle of the night if needed, as well as hotel/village staff. Sporteventi staff will immediately activate if concrete problems arise (indisposition, homesickness, etc.) to alert their families.

We stress that staff generally cannot enter participant rooms for minor privacy reasons (legal provisions) except for justified urgent reasons (examples but not limited to: participant emergency, noise disturbance, illness).

Therefore, it is not possible to monitor participant behavior regarding smartphone use inside rooms nor to seize them (unless directly requested by parents). The only way to regulate smartphone use in participant accommodations is by setting **PARENTAL CONTROLS** by parents/guardians.

**Therefore, we remind that PARENTAL CONTROL activation is ALWAYS MANDATORY by parents/guardians!**

### **DIETARY NEEDS, ALLERGIES AND PHARMACEUTICAL THERAPIES**

All staff, particularly female assistants, support participants with specific **dietary needs** related to specific conditions (celiac disease), severe allergies, religion (Muslims, Indians), or family habits, coordinating with restaurant chefs and kitchen staff.



Furthermore, staff supports participants needing to follow defined **pharmaceutical therapy** during AC Milan Academy Camp or needing to always carry **life-saving medications**.

## **TRAINING AND WEATHER CONDITIONS**

Staff checks weather conditions at least three (3) times daily: morning, early afternoon and evening for the next day. In **mountain locations**, in case of heavy rain, younger AC Milan Academy Camp participants' training (6-9 years old) occurs in the gymnasium.

In **seaside locations**, in case of extreme heat, morning training is advanced 30 minutes and afternoon training is delayed 30-60 minutes.

These are occasional events, but in any case, staff has the duty to protect participants' health.

If staff is aware a participant is particularly tired, they are authorized to stay at hotel for rest, appropriately supervised.

## **TRAINING TECHNICAL MATERIALS**

Sporteventi, during **training sessions**, uses exclusively **its own technical materials** (from goals to cones), completely supplied by **Vivisport srl** (known for supplying goals to most Serie A fields in Italian football championship and having supplied UEFA Champions League goals for the 2016 Final at San Siro); the technical materials in ques-

tion are of **first choice** and in some cases are designed and made by Vivisport exclusively for Sporteventi and are certified for durability, quality and safety.

## **INTERNAL AC MILAN ACADEMY CAMP BUS TRANSFERS WITH PRIVATE BUSES**

All **internal transfers** within AC Milan Academy Camp are done with **minibuses or private buses**. The driver(s) are part of the staff and always available to campers. By internal policy, AC Milan Academy Camp participants never travel on foot but always by vehicle, even if the football field is just a few hundred meters from the hotel.

## **AIRPORT TRANSFERS**

Boys needing **airport transfer** or railway station to camp site and, once AC Milan Academy Camp ends, from camp site to airport or railway station, can rely on a valid service provided by a company specialized in partnership with Sporteventi since 2000. Drivers are people personally known to Sporteventi's office and are in contact with the office before, during and after transfer service. Drivers themselves, if explicitly requested, handle "Unaccompanied Minor" procedures at airport and in any case never leave a camp participant alone in case of inconveniences.

## **INSURANCE INCLUDED IN PRICE**

Sporteventi provides two types of insurance protecting campers:

- **RC Insurance** (for civil liability - RCT) with a maximum of **€5,000,000**
- **Individual accident insurance** for maximum medical expenses of **€1,500.00** (dental max **€1,500.00**)

Individual accident insurance is **effective only for Italian resident participants**. For EU or non-EU youth, they **must arrange insurance covering hospitalization and therapy risks in case of injury**.

Insurance policies are subscribed with Allianz Spa.



## EMERGENCIES

In case of emergencies related to injuries, homesickness, illness or participant misconduct, **staff intervenes immediately** providing first aid or hospitalizing the participant, and contacting parents as soon as possible to discuss the situation and agree on next steps.
